Athlete of Secondary Championships exempted.

Premier Mixed Championships	 4-6 female paddlers for Small boat; 8-12 female paddlers for Standard boat;
Premier Women Championships	All paddlers, helm and drummer must be female.
Senior A Open Championships O40	 Aged 40 or above as of 2019 (Year of Birth), no limitation for helm and drummer. No gender limitation.
Senior B Open Championships O50	 Aged 50 or above as of 2019 (Year of Birth), no limitation for helm and drummer. No gender limitation.
Senior C Open Championships O60	 Aged 60 or above as of 2019 (Year of Birth), no limitation for helm and drummer. No gender limitation.
Youth Open Championships U24	• Under the age of 24 (Birth from 1 January 1996 to 1 October 2007), no limitation for helm and drummer.

Secondary Open Championships	 All paddlers must be FULL TIME students of the secondary schools in the year of 2019-2020; all paddlers are required to provide a copy of their FULL TIME Student, except drummer and helm; Participants shall provide a copy of their valid Student ID Card for check-in on day. All athletes must ware own Personal Floatation Device (PFD), except inflatable PFD. No gender limitation.
Secondary Mixed Championships	 All paddlers must be FULL TIME students of the secondary schools in the year of 2019-2020; all paddlers are required to provide a copy of their FULL TIME Student, except drummer and helm; Participants shall provide a copy of their valid Student ID Card for check-in on day. All athletes must use their own Personal Floatation Device (PFD), except inflatable PFD. Small boat: 4 - 6 female paddlers. No gender limitation of drummer and helm.
"Hong Kong Cup" - Winners of specific races only	 The 6 crews of all local teams' heat of standard boat 500 meters with the best results among the rest of crews in the heats will be qualified to race in final. Restrictions on all athletes' gender and age will base on the heat of categories.

Awards

Premier Open Championships and Premier Mixed Championships

Final A: Champion, 1st runner-up and 2nd runner-up of each category will be awarded a Trophy and Medals (32 for Standard boat and 18 medals for Small boat); The Fourth to Sixth will be awarded a Merit Award Trophy.

Final B & C: Champion, 1st runner-up and 2nd runner-up of each category will be awarded a Trophy; The Fourth to Sixth will be awarded a Merit Award Trophy.

For other championships and "Hong Kong Cup"

The Champion, 1st and 2nd runner-up will be awarded a trophy and medals (32 for Standard boat and 18 medals for Small boat) each. The Fourth to Sixth will be awarded a Merit Award Trophy.

Equipment

- 1) All equipment would be provided by HKCDBA.
- 2) Athletes may use their own paddles, which should meet the requirements set out in accordance with CR 5.2 of the "Amendments for HKCDBA Competition Regulations and Rules of Racing".
- 3) Athletes may use their own Personal Floatation Device (PFD) except inflatable PFD.

Provision of PFDs

200 PFDs will be provided free of charge. NO advance reservation is required. PFDs with limited size and quantity will be allocated on a first come first served basis on site.

Race format

Race format will be announced in forthcoming editions of Race Bulletin.

Race rules and regulations

The latest version of IDBF's "<u>Competition Regulations</u>" and "<u>Rules of Racing</u>", and the "<u>Amendments for HKCDBA Competitions Regulations and Rules of Racing</u>" shall apply.

Race by-law

- 1) Standard boat Team: the maximum number of team members is 34, including 1 team manager, 1 coach, 1 drummer, 1 helm, 16 to 30 paddlers. (A standard dragon boat may carry up to 20 paddlers or not less than 16 paddlers and each boat must carry one drummer and one steerer.)
- 2) Small boat Team: the maximum number of team members is 20, including 1 team manager, 1 coach, 1 drummer, 1 helm, 8 to 16 paddlers. (A small dragon boat may carry up to 10 paddlers or not less than 8 paddlers and each boat must carry one drummer and one steerer.)
- 3) For safety reason, HKCDBA reserve the right to alter the capacity of each dragon boat according to weather condition.
- 4) Team Manager: Each team must assign a member to be the Team Manager. Team Manager wearing the Team Manager Badge shall accompany his/ her team for reporting at the Marshaling Area. Team Manager will be required to stay at the Marshaling Area and under the monitoring of race officials during the race.
- 5) Coach: Team Manager can assign the team coach to race during the second phase of online registration; however, he/ she must observe the entry requirements of respective races. For coaches who would race in any championships, they must register as 2019-20 HKCDBA athletes.
- 6) Substitution of drummer or helm: Any members who registered in second phase of online registration could be substitution of drummer or helm.
- 7) All athletes are not allowed to represent for more than 1 team in each category. That is, sub-teams under the same team name (e.g. ABC Team A and ABC Team B are regarded as 2 teams in the same category).
- 8) All teams are required to report to the Marshaling Area 30 minutes in advance of each race. Teams will be disqualified if they are found not meeting the entry requirements.
- 9) There is no limitation on the number of race entries participated by each organization.
- 10) Category with less than 3 participating teams will be cancelled.
- 11) HKCDBA organizing committee reserves the right to refuse any entry into the races at its sole discretion without given any reasons.
- 12) Any team or athlete who has not demonstrated a good sportsmanship may be disqualified
- 13) Any team (including all team members and accompanying persons) who severely contravenes any race rules and regulations or disciplinary code will be disqualified and/or not entitled for any awards.
- 14) Any actions violate the laws of Hong Kong by the team or athlete may result in disqualification and no refund will be allowed.
- 15) In case of any dispute, the decision of HKCDBA should be final and HKCDBA reserves the right to revise the race regulations at its sole discretion.
- 16) If there is any inconsistency between the English version and Chinese version, the Chinese version

shall prevail.

Crew marquee arrangement

Rental charge of the use of marquee is HK\$500 per marquee for 2 consecutive days. Each team is eligible to apply for only one marquee. Team managers may reserve marquees during the first stage of online registration.

Due to space availability, marquees will be assigned on a first come first served basis. The location of marquees will be assigned by drawing lot. Interested teams shall complete the online registration and settle all payments as confirmation. Floor plan showing the exact location of the marquees will be announced later. Quantity and location of marquees is subject to the actual setup arrangement.

Arrangement under inclement weather

- 1) If typhoon signal No. 1 or above, red or black rainstorm warning signal is in force at 7:00am on the race day, all the races will be cancelled. Entry fee would not be refunded.
- 2) If thunderstorm warning, typhoon signal No. 1 and amber rainstorm warning signal is in force on the race day, all teams shall report on time. Cancellation or delay of races is subject to the final decision of organizing committee. All teams should observe the arrangement announced by organizing committee. Entry fee would not be refunded
- 3) In case weather condition is getting worse during the races, the organizer reserves the right to cancel or postpone the race. Entry fee would not be refunded.
