Race by-law

- 1) There is no limitation on the number of entries by each organisation.
- 2) Each paddler cannot represent different teams (sub-teams under the same team's name (e.g. Team A, Team B) are regarded as different teams) in the same category. All participants should be holders of the HKCDBA Year 2014 Athlete registration card.
- 3) Standard Boat Races: Maximum number of participants in each team should be 40 including 1 team manager, 1 drummer, 1 steersman, 18 paddlers and 19 reserves.
- 4) Small Boat Races: Maximum number of participants in each team should be 30 including 1 team manager, 1 drummer, 1 steersman, 10 paddlers and 17 reserves.
- 5) The coach can take the position of drummer or steersman with clear indication on the crew registration form.
- 6) Reserves for paddlers, drummer and steersman should meet the entry requirement of the corresponding categories.
- 7) Category with less than **3 participating teams** will be cancelled.
- 8) Participants may use their own paddles which must be in accordance with the 5.2 Amendments of HKCDBA Competition Regulations and Rules of Racing.
- 9) HKCDBA Organizing Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry into the races at its sole discretion.
- 10) Any team who severely contravenes rules and regulations or disciplinary code will be disqualified, and are not entitled for any awards.
- 11) HKCDBA reserves the right to restrict the number of first-string paddlers under inclement weather condition for safety reason.
- 12) In case of illegal construction or illegal occupation of public area or destruction of facilities / planting, teams may be prosecuted and disqualified with no refund, please note.

Accommodation & Transport arrangement for overseas teams

The Organizing Committee of the 2014 HKIDBR has made arrangements for a choice of accommodation packages, ranging from **HK\$1,800 to HK\$2,500** per twin room per day, which will include:

- Three to five-star hotels; and
- Arrival/departure transport service (one trip on arrival and one trip on departure, per team)

Information of the transport service provider will be provided in Bulletin (2). Teams can contact the supplier for booking transport between the hotels and the race site at a fee if required.

Information of the accommodation packages will be available in Bulletin (2).

Participants are entitled to make their own arrangements, but races will not be delayed for any teams under any circumstances.

Celebration Dinner

HK\$3,500 will be charged per table for 12 persons. Detailed information of the celebration dinner will be announced in Bulletin (2).

Crew Marquee Arrangement

Rental charge of the use of marquee is HK\$600 per marquee for 3 consecutive days. One club is eligible to apply for only one marquee *.

Due to limited space, only 50 marquees are available for rent. Marquee and onsite location will be assigned on a first come first served basis. To confirm your place, payment on both the entry and marquee fee must accompany the entry forms. The floor plan of marquee setting will be announced later. Full refunds will be paid in the event of cancellation on or before **17 May 2013** via email to hkdba@hkolympic.org. For cancellation received on or **after 18 May 2013**, 50% of the total cost of marquee rental will be reserved. To re-apply after cancellation, another HK\$600 will be imposed if there is still marquee available.

Kindly be reminded that unlawful occupation of unleased land and construction in public areas are illegal and punishable under the Laws of Hong Kong. Teams violated the Laws of Hong Kong will automatically be disqualified without notice and refund.

*Should there be clubs looking for one more marquee, please check out the stock availability of marquee for rent announcement to be sent out on or after 18 May 2013 as total number of marquees provided may vary subject to the actual venue setup conditions.
