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### Awards

Standard Boat Categories – 1 Trophy and 28 medals for each winning team and 1 Trophy for other participating teams.

Small Boat Categories – 1 Trophy and 16 medals for each winning team and 1 Trophy for other participating teams.

#### Race by-law

- 1) Subject to by-law 2 below, there is no limitation on the number of race entries participated by each organisation.
- One paddler cannot represent more than 1 team (sub-teams under the same team name (e.g. Team A, Team B) are regarded as different teams) in the same category. All participants must be holders of the 2015 HKCDBA Athlete registration card.
- 3) Standard Boat Races: Maximum number of participants in each team is 40 including 1 team manager,
   1 drummer, 1 steersman, 18 paddlers and 19 reserves.
- 4) Small Boat Races: Maximum number of participants in each team is be 30 including 1 team manager,
  1 drummer, 1 steersman, 10 paddlers and 17 reserves.
- 5) The coach can also be the drummer or steersman with clear indication on the crew list.
- 6) Reserves for paddlers, drummer and steersman are also subject to the entry requirement of the corresponding categories.
- 7) Each team **must have a Team Manager**, who must be present in the Crew Assembly Area during the time when the team is racing and is under the monitoring of Race Officials.
- 8) Category with less than <u>3 participating teams</u> will be cancelled.
- 9) Participants may use their own paddles in accordance with the [Clause] 5.2 Amendments [Is this name correct?] of HKCDBA Competition Regulations and Rules of Racing.
- 10) HKCDBA Organizing Committee shall have the right to refuse any entry into the races at its sole discretion without providing any reason.
- 11) Any team who severely contravenes rules and regulations or disciplinary code will be disqualified, and are not entitled for any awards.
- 12) HKCDBA reserves the right to restrict the number of racing paddlers according to weather condition for safety reason.
- 13) In case of illegal construction or illegal occupation of public area or destruction of facilities / planting, teams may be prosecuted and disqualified with no refund.

Teams are responsible for all the consequence caused and fees incurred due to late application.

#### Accommodation & Transport arrangement for oversea teams

The Organizing Committee of the 2015 HKIDBR is in the course of making arrangements for the accommodation packages, with price ranging from **HK\$1,400 to HK\$2,500** per twin room per day, which will include:

- Accomodation at a three to five-star hotels; and
- Arrival/departure transport service (one trip on arrival and one trip on departure, per team)

Information of the transport service provider will be provided in Bulletin (2). Teams can contact the supplier for booking additional trips between the hotels and the race site for practices, race or sightseeing at an extra fee if required.

Further information of the accommodation packages will be available in Bulletin (2).

Participants can make their own arrangements, but races will not be delayed for any teams under any circumstances.

#### **Celebration Dinner**

The fee of a table for 12 persons is HK\$3,500. Detailed information of the celebration dinner will be announced in Bulletin (2).

Teams are welcomed to perform different kinds of cultural performances such as magic show, jugglery, and dance during the celebration dinner. 




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# Location of Race Site

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#### Crew Marquee Arrangement

Rental charge of the use of marquee is HK\$600 per marquee for 3 consecutive days. One team is eligible to apply for only one marguee \*. Please reserve marguees online. Free for overseas teams.

Due to limited space, only 50 marguees are available for rent. Marguee will be assigned on a first come first served basis. The location of marquees will be assigned by drawing. The teams shall complete the online enrollment and make payments for both the races and marquee. Floor plan showing the location of the marguees will be announced later. Quantity and location of marguees is subject to the actual setup arrangement.

Full refund will be made in the event of cancellation on or before 4 May 2015 via email to hkdba@hkolympic.org. For cancellation received on or after 5 May 2015, only 50% of the marquee fees will be refunded. To re-apply after cancellation, another HK\$600 will be imposed if there is still marquee available.

Kindly be reminded that unlawful occupation of unleased land and construction in public areas are illegal and punishable under the Laws of Hong Kong. Teams violated the Laws of Hong Kong will automatically be disqualified without notice and refund.

\*For teams which may wish to rent more than one marquee, please keep an eye on the announcement regarding the allocation of marquees which will be available on or after 2 June 2015.

#### **Provision of PFDs**

#### All the participants must be able to swim 100m in light clothing WITHOUT buoyancy aid.

200 PFDs will be provided free of charge. NO advance reservation is required. PFDs with limited size and quantity will be allocated on a first come, first served basis on the spot.
