The 2015 World Dragon Boat Racing Championships, in addition to the championships, will also involve the IDBF Congress, Council Meeting, Women in Coaching seminar and Officials Training. Racing for the 2015 World Dragon Boat Racing Championships will take place from August 19th – 23rd inclusive, with the Opening Ceremony on Monday August 17th, 2015. Competing Teams for the WDBRC are expected to arrive in Welland between Friday August 14th and Monday August 17th, 2015.

Once a request is made, a member of the 2015 WDBRC Organizing Committee will forward a spreadsheet to be completed. One invitation letter will be provided for the entire team.

Note: Canadian Visas are not available at the border or airport upon entry to Canada, visas must be obtained before travel to Canada.

2. WDBRC Administration Fee

3. Accommodation

Although the initial period for requesting Official Accommodation from the 2015 WDBRC Organizing Committee has now passed there are still accommodations available through the 2015 WDBRC Organizing Committee.

Niagara is comprised of 12 distinct and vibrant communities, all just a short drive from the Venue. The 2015 WDBRC Organizing Committee is working in partnership with various accommodations and tourism operators throughout the Niagara Region to offer participants the best experience possible, on and off the water.

A variety of hotel accommodations have been arranged with pricing as low as USD \$68.00/CAD \$80.00 per person, per night, based on double occupancy with two beds per room. There are accommodation options for other occupancies, including single university residence accommodation starting at just USD \$51.00/CAD \$60.00, or triple, quad, and five/six participants per room, bed sharing options at a variety of area hotels. Event transportation will only be provided for those Teams staying at an Official Accommodation.

The 2015 WDBRC Organizing Committee will do its best to place participants at requested accommodations, based on availability.

LUNCH

Lunch packages are available for purchase at the Venue for Training and Racing Days (Sun Aug 16 to Sun Aug 23). Lunches are a healthy choice, minimum 1500 calories, and will vary daily. Lunches will be delivered directly to your Athlete Village tent at a predetermined time. Lunches will be USD \$12.00/CAD \$13.00 per person per day and will contain:

BREAKFAST AND DINNER

AIRPORT WELCOMING SERVICE

The 2015 WDBRC Organizing Committee will have welcome centres at Toronto Person International (YYZ), Hamilton International Airport (YHM), and Buffalo International Airport (BUF). Teams who purchase an airport transfer from the 2015 WDBRC Organizing Committee will be greeted upon arrival and directed to their bus/van that will transport your team to your accommodations in Niagara.

In the event of lost luggage, the 2015 WDBRC Organizing Committee with assist all participants, officials, and supporters with the retrieval of their luggage. Once the luggage is found, the 2015 WDBRC Organizing Committee will arrange to have the luggage brought to Niagara and returned to its owner.

VENUE SHUTTLES

The 2015 WDBRC Organizing Committee is excited to offer a wide selection of transportation services, including, the option to order:

- Dedicated AM Venue Shuttle for your individual team (up to 55 passengers)
- Daily Regular Venue shuttle to each Official Accommodation operating on a schedule
- Daily Tourism Shuttle to Niagara Falls for all shuttle pass holders
- Dedicated PM Venue Shuttle

Dedicated AM Venue Shuttles

Teams have the option to book morning shuttles dedicated to their team, which provides a shuttle to the Venue from their Official Accommodations, each morning. Those Teams who opt-in to the Dedicated AM Venue Shuttle, receive a bus or busses dedicated to their Team for a transfer from their Official Accommodation to the Venue at the time your Team schedules on each day purchased for. The Dedicated AM Venue Shuttle is available for lease on both training days and competition days.

Team Managers will be required to inform the 2015 WDBRC Organizing Committee a minimum 48 hours in advance as to what time in the morning they would like their transfer from their Official Accommodations to the Venue. Teams who opt-in for the Dedicated AM Venue Shuttle receive full, complimentary access to the Daily Venue Shuttle (available on Training and Competition Days on same day as purchase), and complimentary access to the Tourism Shuttle to Niagara Falls (available on competition days, on the same day as dedicated shuttle purchase).

Dedicated Morning Transfer - USD \$1075/CAD \$1265

- * On average, the cost is USD \$20.00/CAD \$23.00 per person per day, based on 55 passengers
- * Teams who opt-in for the dedicated bus transfer will receive the Daily Venue Shuttle service and Tourism Shuttle service to Niagara Falls complimentary

Dedicated PM Venue Shuttles

Teams wishing to order a Dedicated PM Venue Shuttle can book through the 2015 WDBRC Organizing Committee. The Dedicated PM Venue Shuttle allows Teams the flexibility to return to their accommodations at a time that best suits the needs of the crew. Allowing Teams to leave the Venue without having to wait or catch the Daily Venue Shuttle. Team Managers will be required to inform the 2015 WDBRC Organizing Committee a minimum 48 hours in advance as to what time in the morning they would like their transfer from the Venue to their Official Accommodations.

Dedicated Afternoon Transfer - USD \$700/CAD \$825

- * On average, the cost works out to be USD \$13.00/CAD \$15.00 per person per day, based on 55 passengers
- * Teams who opt-in for the dedicated bus transfer will receive the Daily Venue Shuttle service and Tourism Shuttle service to Niagara Falls complimentary

Daily Venue Shuttle

The 2015 WDBRC Organizing Committee will also be offering a regularly scheduled, looping, shuttle service from all Official Accommodation locations to the Venue and back, for all participants and supporters, running until one hour after the last race daily. Teams will be able to purchase a shuttle pass to have access to the shuttle service that will regularly loop between all Official Accommodations and the Venue.

Daily Venue Shuttle USD \$17.00/CAD \$20.00 /person/day

Independent Transportation Services

For Teams who select to arrange their own transportation with an independent transportation services, there is a site access fee that must be paid upon each entrance to the Venue.

The site access fee for any independent transportation service is CAD \$100 per bus, per day. No parking will be available on site for any independent buses.

The 2015 WDBRC Organizing Committee is not responsible for any outside arrangements made by Teams.

6. Celebration

Celebrating fierce competition, new friendships, and a shared passion of dragon boat, Closing Ceremonies will take place on the evening of August 23rd, 2015. It will be an event you will not soon forget – a night of music and dancing under the stars with the waterway lit with fire pods as the backdrop. Food trucks, drinks, and a photo booth are some of the many features of the Closing Ceremonies as well as there will be a separate party in the same location for Junior athletes to enjoy.

7. Tourism Excursions

Tour and package descriptions, pricing, and pre-booking information will be posted on www.wdbrc2015.ca by mid-May. Tours will be available from August 12th through August 26th. Pricing will range from \$3 to \$253 CAD (applicable taxes are included). Transportation will be included in the pricing of each tour. Individuals will be picked up at the Welland International Flatwater Centre and will dropped off at their accommodation. Special arrangements can be made in regards to transportation locations. Private and group bookings are encouraged.

Various tours will be available to purchase onsite at the Venue during training and competition days and will not require pre-booking. However, pre-bookings are strongly encouraged for out-of-town tours and to avoid disappointment.

PAYMENT FOR ACCOMMODATION AND SERVICES

The 2015 WDBRC Organizing Committee will be accepting payment for services offered by the Organizing Committee (Accommodations, Meals, and/or Transportation) in Canadian (CAD) and American (USD) currency. On the Services Request Form, teams must indicate which currency they prefer to be invoiced in.

Note: The Canadian (CAD) pricing rates, outlined in this Bulletin, are not subject to change. The American (USD) pricing rates outlined in this Bulletin are subject to change based on exchange rate at time of invoicing.

PAYMENT DEADLINES

Deposits are to be paid by electronic transfer in CAD or USD to the 2015 WDBRC Organizing Committee. Accommodation, Meals, and Transportation will be subject to applicable local taxes and applicable hospitality fees. Federations will receive a pro forma invoice for Accommodations, Meals, and Transportation prior to payment dates and a final invoice for settlement with the July 3rd Remaining Balance Payment.

CANCELLATION TERMS

In the event of an Accommodation, Meals, and/or Transportation cancellation, a charge will be made equivalent to any loss suffered by 2015 WDBRC.

After May 1, 2015: 30% of total costs After June 1, 2015: 50% of total costs After July 3, 2015: 100% of total costs

TAXES

Services offered by the 2015 WDBRC Organizing Committee are subject to applicable local taxes and applicable hospitality fees. Rates provided in this Bulletin for Accommodations, Meals, and Transportation are not inclusive of taxes. In Canada, there are mandatory sales taxes that is levied by the provincial and federal governments. In Ontario, there is a 13% Harmonized Sales Tax (HST) consumption tax, that we are required by law to charge. The 13% HST will be charged on Accommodations, Meals, and Transportation.

REGISTRATION HEADQUARTERS

The Registration Headquarters will be located at the Welland Recreational Canal Corporation's Community Office located at the Seaway Mall in Welland. Team Manager(s) will have a scheduled appointment time at the Registration Headquarters. ANTI DOPING

COMPETITOR'S RIGHTS

- Be notified of selection for doping control
- Be informed of the consequences of refusing to provide a sample
- Have the doping control procedures explained
- Be provided with a selection of sealed equipment from which to choose
- Be observed when providing sample by someone of the same gender
- Receive copies of all signed documentation

COMPETITOR'S RESPONSIBLITIES

- Know the IDBF and your IDBF Member's anti-doping regulations
- Carry photo ID to present to the Doping Control Officer (DCO)
- Inform your doctor or pharmacist that you are a competitor who may be subject to doping control
- Consult your IDBF Member in advance if you are medically required to take any medication on the prohibited list before being permitted to take such substances, you will need to apply for medical exemption
- Keep a list of all medications, vitamins or supplements you are taking and declare them on the doping control form
- Be careful with unlicensed products such as nutritional supplements or herbal products as these may contain prohibited substances
- From notification through to completion of sample collection, stay in full view of the DCO or chaperone, whether at a competition, training venue or your home
- Re-hydrate with sealed non-alcoholic, caffeine- free beverage before the test
- Be prepared to begin sample collection procedures as soon as possible after notification

CHAMPIONSHIPS AND ENTRIES

ALL COMPETITION CLASSES - ONE ENTRY PER TEAM, PER COMPETITION CLASS ONLY

Standard Boat Championships will be held over 200m, 500m, 1000m and 2000m in the Competition Classes shown on the following page (some exceptions for 1000m and 2000m as noted in chart). A Standard Mixed Crew is a minimum of eight (8) and maximum of twelve (12) female paddlers. Reserve Paddlers: Four (4) maximum.

Small Boat Championships will be held over 200m, 500m and in some cases 2000m. A Small Mixed crew is a minimum of four (4) and a maximum of six (6) female Paddlers. Reserve Paddlers: Two (2) maximum.

Age Regulations:

18-23: Aged 18 to 23 inclusive as at June 1st, 2015.

Standard Boat: four (4) Crew Members may be 16-17 years old and two (2) may be 24-25 years old. **Small Boat:** three (3) Crew Members may be 16-17 and one (1) aged 24-25 years old.

Senior A: Aged 40 or over as at June 1st, 2015

Senior B: Aged 50 or over as at June 1st, 2015

Senior C: Aged 60 or over as at June 1st, 2015

Entry Conditions

The Small Boat Championships are primarily for new and developing IDBF Member Countries. Normally IDBF Basic and Associate Members who have not taken part in a WDBRC previously or for at least the last four (4) years.

By exception IDBF Members who have taken part in a WDBRC in the past four years but who are unable to send Standard Boat Crews in a particular Racing class may be permitted to compete in the Small Boat Championships at the discretion of the Chairman of the IDBF Competition and Technical Committee (C&TC). For example, an IDBF Member with only twelve (12) racers of either sex available who has competed in a previous WDBRC, may be allowed to enter Small Boat Open or Women's Crews in a specific Racing Class.

Any IDBF Member who is unable to field Standard Boats in the developing Racing Classes – that is the Junior Division, the 18-24s and Senior C Racing Classes, may enter these specific Small Boat competitions without reference to the C&TC.

In the Mixed Championship Races where there are insufficient Women or Men available for a Mixed Standard Boat Crew, that is when there are less than eighteen (18) racers in either an Open or Women's crew, the racers concerned may be used to form a Mixed Small Boat crew. Teams entering both Small Boat Open and Women's Crews may only enter a Standard Boat Mixed Crew, not a Small Boat Mixed Crew.

A Team cannot enter both a Standard Boat and Small Boat in the same competition class. A Team entered in the Standard Boat 1000m/2000m cannot enter the Small Boat 200m/500m classes.

ONLINE REGISTRATION

Teams are required to submit both their Confirmed Entries and Final Named Entries (team member details, image etc.) online at https://idbfchamps.org/login_idbf.php.

The deadline for Confirmed Entries is May 15th, 2015
