- 1. A blanked crew list in excel format will be received by each team manager via the email provided during application subject to the confirmation of enrollment and payment.

Draw of race lanes and Team Managers' Meeting (Online)

1900 hours

Results will be announced on HKCDBA website after the meeting.

The organizer will conduct briefing on race rules and regulations, race format, onsite arrangement and distribute race materials (if any).

The link of the online meeting will be sent to team manager one week before by email.

NOTE: All teams must comply with the race rules and regulations and arrangements announced at the Team Managers' meeting.

Awards

: All Championships, final A and final B - Champion, 1st runner-up and 2nd runner-up of each category will be awarded a Trophy and 18 Medals;

Equipment

All equipment will be provided by HKCDBA;

Athletes can use their own paddles for the race, the requirement of the paddles must comply with 5.2 Amendments for HKCDBA Competition Regulations and Rules of Racing;

Athletes can use their own Personal Floatation Device (PFD) for racing, except the Inflatable PFD.

It will be run in accordance to the latest version of IDBF Competitions Regulations and Rules of Racing and the latest version of Amendments for HKCDBA Competitions Regulations.

Crew marquee arrangement

Rental charge of the use of marquee is HK\$300 per marquee with HK\$600 deposit per marquee. Each team is eligible to apply for one marquee only. Team managers may reserve marquees during the first stage of online registration.

Due to space availability, marquees will be assigned on a first come first served basis. The location of marquees will be assigned by drawing lot. Interested teams shall complete the online registration and settle all payments as confirmation. Floor plan showing the exact location of the marquees will be announced later. Quantity and location of marquees is subject to the actual setup arrangement.

(Separate crossed cheque(s) for entry fee(s) (i.e. 1 cheque for 1 race category) and crew marquee rental fee is a must)

Arrangement under Inclement Weather

- If typhoon signal No. 3 or above, red or black rainstorm warning signal is in force at 0700 hours. on the race day, all the races will be cancelled. Entry fee would not be refunded.
- If thunderstorm warning, typhoon signal No. 1, amber rainstorm warning signal is in force on the race day, all teams shall report on time. Cancellation or delay of races is subject to the final decision of organizing committee. All teams should obey the arrangement announced by organizing committee.
- In case weather condition is getting worse during the races, the organizer reserves the right to cancel or postpone the race. Entry fee would not be refunded.

Payment method

Crossed cheque and make the fees payable to "Hong Kong China Dragon Boat Association" and state clearly the race name, categories enrolled and team name at the back of cheques. Submit the cheque by hand or by post to Unit 21, 28/F, New Tech Plaza, 34 Tai Yau Street, San Po Kong, Kowloon

The event can be hosted is subject to the approval of the event licenses issued by the Marine Department and the Food and Health Bureau.

Participant must comply with the Prevention and Control of Disease (Requirements and Directions) (Business and Premises) Regulation, Chapter 599F and the Prevention and Control of Disease (Prohibition on Gathering) Regulation, Chapter 599G

Race By-Law

- 1. All athletes are required to have valid Hong Kong Identity Card.
- 2. All paddlers in secondary school must be FULL TIME students of the secondary schools in the year of 2022-23; all paddlers are required to provide a copy of their FULL TIME Student card, except drummer and helm
- 3. Maximum number of athletes in each team should be 20 (i.e. 1 team manager, 1 coach, 1 drummer, 1 helm, 8 16 paddlers).
- 4. There is no limitation on the number of entries for each organization.
- 5. Categories with less than 3 entries may be cancelled.
- 6. Team Manager: each team must have a Team Manager or the appointed Team Manager who is required to standby in the Crew Assembly Area, i.e. easily be seen and called by Race Officials, during the time when the team is racing.
- 7. Coach: the coach can take up the role of a drummer, a helm or paddler provided that there is a clear indication on the crew list (crew registration form) and holding the valid athlete card.
- 8. Substitution of drummer or helm: anyone on the registered crew list are allowed to act as the backup of the drummer or helm.
- 9. Substitutions: all substitutions should meet the technical entry requirement of their own categories.
- 10. All athletes are not allowed to represent more than 1 team in each category. That is, subteams under the same team name Team A and Team B are regarded as 2 teams in the same category.
- 11. All athletes must be holders of HKID and be able to present the **ORIGINAL copy** for onsite identification check in required.
- 12. Entries of secondary Open and secondary Women categories should submit crew identity declaration forms together with copies of respective staff / students ID cards and the entry forms. Athletes of these categories should present the **ORIGINAL copy** of their student ID cards for onsite identification check.
- 13. With the concern of safety under bad weather condition, HKCDBA organizing committee reserves the right to decide the number of athletes on boat.
- 14. Any team, including Team Manager, Coach, Athletes and Crew Members, who severely contravenes rules and regulations or disciplinary code will be disqualified, and are not entitled for any awards.
- 15. Any team or athlete who don't demonstrate a good sportsmanship may be disqualified
- 16. Any action violate the law of Hong Kong by the team or athlete may result in disqualification and no refund will be allowed.
- 17. HKCDBA organizing committee reserves the right to refuse any entry into the races at its sole discretion.
- 18. In case of any dispute, the decision of HKCDBA should be final and reserves the right to revise the race regulations at its sole discretion.
- 19. If there is any inconsistency between the English version and Chinese version, the Chinese version shall prevail.

Selection of affiliated club team in participating Oversea Dragon Boat Races

- Once invitation has been received from organizing body, Hong Kong China Dragon Boat Association ("HKCDBA") will announce overseas races bulletin to all valid members once HKCDBA receive any invitation from organizing body.
- 2) All overseas races (Excepted Club Crew World Championships) invited by organizing body to delegate affiliated team as Hong Kong Dragon Boat Team Representative. The sanction priority as follows:

1st Priority

Affiliated club team who participated in "Hong Kong Dragon Boat Championships 2019", endorsement will be determined by draw lots.

2nd Priority

Affiliated club team who did not participate in "Hong Kong Dragon Boat Championship", endorsement will be determined by draw lots.

Others

Any remaining quota or unlimited self-financed application for such event, all HKCDBA valid members are available for recommendation by HKCDBA.

Note:

- 1) All endorsed teams must be the valid Members of HKCDBA in year 2022-23.
- 2) The top rank of affiliated club team as above sanction priority will be awarded as the host team or sponsor package by organizing body if any.
- 3) The affiliated club team will be the bottom level of above priority arrangement if the affiliated club team awarded any host team or sponsor package in 2017-2019.
- 4) All teams being recommended by HKCDBA in participating at such event, should follow all rules and regulation announced by the organizing body.
- 5) All involved cost and arrangement in participating race shall be responsible by team themselves.
- 6) HKCDBA holds the final decision and interpretation of selection criteria stated as above. No objection could be made.

Notice of Selection affiliated club in participating at "IDBF Club Crew World Championships" Selection Criteria and Entry Requirement

"Hong Kong Dragon Boat Championships 2022 (500M)" will be the qualification event of "IDBF Club Crew World Championships". Selection criteria and entry requirement are as follows:

According to the final result of specific category(ies) in "Hong Kong Dragon Boat Championships 2022 (500M)", the best race time of club will be entitled the first priority endorsement to specific category(ies) of "IDBF Club Crew World Championships". The quota will be determined by organizing committee of "IDBF Club Crew World Championships".

Entry Requirement:

- All participating clubs are requested to conform to the rules and regulations of Organizer;
- All endorsed club must be the valid club members of HKCDBA;
- Once the endorsement list is submitted to the Organizer, all enrollment procedure and application arrangement and fees are responsible by the endorsed club;
- HKCDBA reserves the right of the final decision on all mentioned arrangements and endorsements.

Others:

All valid club members of HKCDBA are eligible to apply the rest of quota(s). If applications are more than the remaining quota(s), endorsement will be determined by draw lots.

If there is any inconsistency between the English version and Chinese version, the Chinese version shall prevail.

Remarks: Hong Kong Dragon Boat Championships (small boat) and Hong Kong Dragon Boat Championships (standard boat) will be held every other year alternately.
