Practical, Certification and Registration:	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Practical - Upon receiving the certificate, qualified participants of the course will be assigned a practical by the Hong Kong China Dragon Boat Association.</li> <li>2. Registration - Within 12 months after successfully completing the course and receiving the completion certificate, participants are required to pass one internship assessment. The internship should be completed through participation in a full-day event or two half-day events.</li> </ol>

4. Once successfully enrolled, change of class or change of participants is strictly prohibited. Fees shall not be refundable.
5. Successful candidates in enrolment shall receive notice 1 week before by email.
6. Non-selected candidates shall receive course fee and certification fee refund.
7. The course shall be cancelled if the enrolment falls below 10.
8. If typhoon signal 3 or above, red or black rainstorm signal hoisted 2 hours prior to date of course, session of the day shall be cancelled, date of make-up class depends on venue arrangement. If Thunderstorm warning, amber rainstorm or Typhoon signal no.1 hosted, candidates are required to report at venue. Course shall be determined by instructor whether proceed or cancelation.
9. If participant fails the retest assessment, they must retake the course and pay the course fee again. Please reminded that a Pass in course examination does not imply as "Registered Dragon Boat Race Official". Candidate shall proceed ongoing register procedures.
10. HKCDBA reserves the right to amend/interpret this course information without prior notice.
11. If there is any inconsistency between the English version and Chinese version, the Chinese version shall prevail.
