Hong Kong China Dragon Boat Association introduction

Hong Kong China Dragon Boat Association is an organization that manages dragon boat activities in Hong Kong. It is affiliated with Sports Federation and Olympic Committee of Hong Kong China. It is also a founding member of International Dragon Boat Federation and that of Asian Dragon Boat Federation. Hong Kong China Dragon Boat Association comprises dragon boat activities. Currently, there are over 100 members eligible for balloting and over 2000 individual members.

As a coordinating organization for Hong Kong dragon boat races, Hong Kong China Dragon Boat Association is dedicated to preserving the culture and historical tradition of dragon boat races, promoting Hong Kong and international dragon boat race development, as well as selecting and training local dragon boat athletes, and organizing umpire and coach training courses.

Beneficiary Organization

Hong Kong Federation of Handicapped Youth introduction

Hong Kong Federation of Handicapped Youth, established in 1970, is a government registered charitable organization managed by people with disabilities. Since aspects of education, employment and welfare facilities for the disabled were not paid with much attention at the time, tens of the people with physical disabilities joined together and formed HKFHY aiming to advocate for the best interest of the disabled.

Being a self-help organization with the longest history in Hong Kong that serves mainly the physically handicapped and chronic ill, aside from operating services that are subvented by the Social Welfare Department, the Federation continuously develops various innovative services and businesses that fit in the needs of the disabled. Currently, the Federation provides services include Jockey Club Activity Centre, Employment Service Centre, Momentum Academy and Stanley Bradbury Bath Shed (a fully accessible beach house for the disabled); self-financed social enterprises including First Sense Design and Flower Workshop. Through the aforesaid means, we aim to strengthen the confidence and social network of the disabled and enhance their job skills and employment opportunities, so that they can re-integrate into the society easily.
