

## Kellett Island Cup 2022 Sunday 26th June - Race Information

The Kellett Island Cup is back in 2022! The race will be held out of the RHKYC clubhouse at Kellett Island in Wan Chai Basin and takes place in the waters of Hong Kong's Victoria Harbour.

### **Events will be offered in the following categories:**

- \*Boat classes: **Small boat**: 10 paddlers, one drummer, one steerer, a crew of 12 Racers
- Mixed boat requires 50% of male crew and 50% of female crew. Drummer & Steerer is excepted.
- A paddler may compete in Junior event until 31st of December of the year in which (s)he reaches the age of 18, i.e. Junior competitors must have been born on or after 1st January 2004.

### Covid-19

The Vaccine Pass is now in effect. The Royal Hong Kong Yacht Club currently has precautionary measures in place which can be found <u>here</u>. Please ensure you have uploaded your latest vaccination record or medical exemption onto your **LeaveHomeSafe app**, or you have paper copies with you (where applicable). Further, the Vaccine Pass has three phases, please check that you are up to date with your vaccinations.

#### **Entries:**

- The committee retain the right to limit the number of crews in any event where there is higher demand than expected. Where entry slots are limited due to scheduling constraints, places will be awarded in order of entries received (i.e. preference will be given to those entries received, and paid for, first).
- Clubs can only enter one team in each category. There will be a maximum 16 entries per category.
- Club Captains must ensure that they only enter competent crews and that their crews are properly prepared for the race. All competitors should be able to swim at least 50m in light clothing.
- Entries close at 1159hrs on Tuesday 14th JUNE 2022 and should use the official E-entry form <a href="https://www.cognitoforms.com/RhkycRps/KellettIslandCUP2022">https://www.cognitoforms.com/RhkycRps/KellettIslandCUP2022</a> (or scan the QR code) and the link will be emailed to each club and posted on our club event page. Payment for entries should be completed at the same time to guarantee your place. Crews information will be required in later stage by another online form for Race card production.
- Entries will be charged at \$1800 per boat per entry.

#### When making entries, please note the following local rules:

- Each team can apply ONE boat for Open, Women & Mixed event respectively in each cup category.
- The committee reserves the right to cancel specific events in the event of insufficient entries.
- Drummer & steerer do not need to be junior on Junior boats.
- All Junior paddlers will be required to wear personal flotation devices (PFDs), whilst the boats must be equipped
  with PFDs for each rower to be used in an emergency these will be provided by the organisers.






### The Course:
