

Race Manual:

- 1. Entry fee is non-refundable and non-transferable if application is accepted.
- 2. The Committee will draw lots if the quota is full.
- 3. Each team must provide the team name both in Chinese and English language, otherwise if it is decided by the Organizer. No protest will be entered into.
- 4. All disputes will be arbitrated by the organizer.
- 5. Participants are responsible for their own insurance.
- 6. No team can change the team name after entry.
- 7. Each team must wear the team uniform during the race.
- 8. The orders of the Committee and judges must be strictly observed. Any team failing to observe the orders of the Judges or who do not behave properly may be disqualified by the Committee.
- 9. Each team should appoint 2 team leaders to liaise with the Committee and to be responsible for receiving the award.
- 10. The committee does not have any liability for injuries, death or loss of properties of any crew as result of any accident. Any person who is a non-swimmer or is physically unfit for strenuous exercise is not allowed to participate in the race.
- 11. The Committee may be entitled to forfeit the deposit in the following cases:
 - 11.1- If damage to or loss of equipment on practice day and race day. (If the deposit is insufficient to cover, team must compensate for the difference).
 - 11.2- Withdraw after the ballot.

Sha Tin Dragon Boat Race 2022 in Celebration of the 25th Anniversary of Reunification cum Inter-District Invitational Race

Competition Rules

- 1. Each participating team must obey the instructions of the committee and the referee. If there is any person who does not comply with the referee's decision or deliberately causes trouble, the committee has the right to disqualify him from the competition.
- 2. Each team leader/team must ensure that the items, materials, clothing and team members displayed themselves at the competition venue will not engage in acts that endanger the Law of the People's Republic of China on Safeguarding National Security in the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region of the People's Republic of China. The committee will not be responsible for any violation of the law mentioned above.
- 3. The team leader of each participating team must supervise the discipline of the team members. If there is any intentional disturbance, the committee has the right to disqualify them from the competition and impose a one-year suspension.
- 4. In the event of any exceptional incidents, the committee has the right to make arrangements concerning the selection of boats. The participating teams shall not object. Those who refuse will automatically deem to abstain.
- 5. The competition begins with a single start system. If any team has false starts or fouls, the competition will continue, and the team that has false starts or fouls will finally be disqualified.
- 6. All participating teams must report to the marshaling area with their player card 30 minutes before the starting time of each group. After marshal, the committee will draw lots for the boats in the embarkation area. If there is any violation, the team will be disqualified immediately.
- 7. Each participating team must check by the committee to verify the number of participants. If it is found that there are too many or insufficient participants, they will immediately be disqualified from the competition.
- 8. Teams will not be allowed to compete in standing or half-squatting positions. Any violation will result in immediate disqualification.
- 9. All participating teams must use the paddles provided by the committee. If they violate the rules, they will immediately be disqualified, and the rankings won in the competition will not be validated.
- 10. Before the race starts, all dragon boats should line up at the starting point. The steersman must tightly pull the rope from the floating platform. The drummer should stop beating, and all the paddles should place beside the boat. Any violation will result in immediate disqualification.
- 11. During the competition, each dragon boat must proceed according to the proper waterway, and it is not allowed to cross the lines. The color flags on the dragon boat should spread out and are not allowed to be tied up. No other flags can be erect without authorization. Any violation will result in immediate disqualification.

- 12. After the competition, each team must return the dragon boat and equipment to the committee as soon as possible. If the team intentionally destroys the equipment or sinks the dragon boat, the committee has the right to disqualify the team's result and its right to participate in the future. At the same time, all repair costs will be fully borne by the team.
- 13. The leader of the winning team in the finals (1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th) must immediately report to the podium and wait for the prize-giving ceremony. After the official announcement of the results, the leader should receive the award accordingly. Otherwise, the committee will find others to receive the award on behalf of the team.
- 14. During the competition, TV broadcasts, film documentaries, and interviews with TV stations, radio stations, and newspapers will be decided and arranged by the committee. Teams are not allowed to make arrangements by themselves. Any violation will result in
- 15. Teams are strictly prohibited from performing worship ceremonies anywhere in the event venue. Anyone who violates the rules will immediately be disqualified from the competition.
- 16. The committee will not be held responsible for any accidental injury, death, or property damage to the competitors during practice and competition. Those who are not familiar with water sports and are not suitable for strenuous exercise are not allowed to participate.
- 17. The committee may amend the above rules at any time without prior notice.
