- 3. Junior, Youth A & B: All paddlers should be aged under 23, 18 and 16 respectively in 2015.





Champion, 1st runner-up and 2nd runner-up of each category will be awarded.

Standard boat races: 30 Medals; Small boat races: 18 Medals.



Arrangement under inclement weather

- 1. If typhoon signal No. 3 or above, red or black rainstorm warning signal is in force at 6am on the race day, all the races will be cancelled. Entry fee would not be refunded.
- If thunderstorm warning, typhoon signal No. 1, amber rainstorm warning signal is in force on the race day, all teams shall report on time. Cancellation or delay of races is subject to the final decision of organizing committee. All teams should obey the arrangement announced by organizing committee.
- 3. In case weather condition is getting worse during the races, the organizer reserves the right to cancel or postpone the race. Entry fee would not be refunded.

Race by-law

- 1. There is no limitation on number of entries of each organization.
- 2. Each paddler cannot represent different teams (sub-teams under the same team's name (Team A, Team B) are regarded as different teams) in the same category.
- Standard Boat: Maximum number of participants in each team should be 34 including 1 team 3. manager, 1 coach, 1 drummer, 1 steersman, 20 paddlers and 10 substitutions.
- 4. Small Boat: Maximum number of participants in each team should be 20 including 1 team manager, 1 coach, 1 drummer, 1 steersman, 10 paddlers and 6 substitutions.
- 5. There is no gender limitation in Open Category.
- 6. All Paddlers, Steersman and drummer must be female in Women Category.
- There no limitation on the gender of steersman and drummer in Mixed Category. It should be 7. consist of at least 8 female paddlers and up to a maximum of 12 in Standard Boat Races while at least 4 female paddlers and up to a maximum of 6 in Small Boat Races.
- 8. Teams must appoint a Team manager stay in marshalling area and communicate with staff during the race.
- 9. Coach can take the position of drummer or steersman. It should be marked on the crew registration form.
- 10. Substitutions for paddlers, drummer and steersman should meet the entry requirement of the categories participated.
- 11. Category with less than 3 participating teams will be cancelled.
- 12. All participants should be holders of 2015-16 HKCDBA registered athlete cards and present their ORIGINAL HKCDBA athlete Card for checking on the race day. For those who cannot present the HKCDBA athlete cards for any reasons, replacement with payment (HK\$100@ card) should be made on the spot.
- 13. Participants may use their own paddles which must be in accordance to 5.2 Amendments of HKCDBA Competition Regulations and Rules of Racing.
- 14. HKCDBA organizing committee reserves the right to refuse any entry into the races at its sole discretion.
- 15. Any team who severely contravenes rules and regulations or disciplinary code will be disqualified, and are not entitled for any awards.
- 16. In case of discrepancy between Chinese and English information in this Bulletin, Chinese version shall prevail.

Special Notice - Oversea Races

- If HKCDBA was invited to join the oversea races which is not limited to Hong Kong National Team, e.g., Inter Hong Kong-Macau Race and Club Crew World Championships, HKCDBA will invite the dragon boat teams of highest rankings in specific categories in the Hong Kong Dragon Boat Championships (HKC) of previous year to join the races. Number of teams to be sanctioned depends on the oversea race requirement. Sanctioned teams should be valid HKCDBA voting members, fulfill the entire oversea races entry requirement and join the race at their own costs. (All teams should apply by their own to participate in overseas races included the 1st Asian Dragon Boat Club Cup and Club Crew World Championships)
- 2. If the specific category was cancelled in HKC, teams who have joined HKC are entitled to be sanctioned. The rest quota will be determined by the teams' frequency of participation in HKCDBA race this year. If no suitable team(s) to be selected, sanction will be determined by drawing.
- 3. All sanctioned teams should comply with all the race rules and regulations.

Affiliated Club Representative Team Program

Outline

To give impetus to the sports of dragon boating in becoming an elite sport in Hong Kong, elevate the level of local trainings, race specifications and standards, as well as strengthen the motivation of affiliated dragon boat clubs, HKCDBA now offers a fair competition mechanism through positive competition. The best performing affiliated club will become the Affiliated Club Representative Team taking part in a designated international dragon boat race abroad.





17th Hong Kong Dragon Boat Championships

26 & 27 September 2015 (Saturday & Sunday)

Criteria

- Commencing the "16th Hong Kong Dragon Boat Championship" this year, the winner of the annual Hong Kong Cup Standard Boat 500-meter Race will automatically become the Affiliated Club Representative Team.
- 2. The Hong Kong Cup Race is a standard boat 500-meter race held at the annual Hong Kong Dragon Boat Championship. The best time of the first 6 teams from all categories in the heats of the annual Hong Kong Dragon Boat Championship will win a place in this race.
- Participating club must be an active member of HKCDBA and indicate in the application form 3. that the club is willing to accept as the Affiliated Club Representative Team once winning the respective race. (*MUST fill in the Declaration of Affiliated Club Representative Team on application form)
- The winner, 1st and 2nd runner ups of the Hong Kong Cup Race will become the Affiliated Club Representative Team which will be recommended to participate in designated international dragon boat race abroad as Hong Kong Affiliated Clubs.
- 5. If the winner of the Hong Kong Cup is unable to participate in designated international dragon boat race abroad, the 1st runner-up will take over the opportunity and so on.
- If the 2nd runner up is also unable to take part, the program will be suspended for the year. That is, no Hong Kong Affiliated Clubs will be sent to designated international dragon boat races.

Responsibilities of HKCDBA

- Provide sponsorship to the Affiliated Club Representative Team as subsidies for the trip, such as accommodation, transport and so on.
- 2. Provide team uniform.
- 3. Assist the Affiliated Club Representative Team submit relevant Entry documents for the race.
- Assist the Affiliated Club Representative Team for transportation and accommodation 4. arrangements.
- Dispatch a team manager to squad the Affiliated Club Representative Team throughout the 5. trip.
- 6. Oversee the discipline and behavior the Affiliated Club Representative Team and take appropriate disciplinary actions if needed.

Responsibilities of the Affiliated Club Representative Team

- Organize a team of 28 dragon boat players (including a team-in-charge, a coach and 26 athletes) and conduct tremendous trainings in preparing for the race.
- 2. Within the team of 28, 22 or more team members must have been registered in the crew list of the Hong Kong Cup Race.

- 3. Responsible for all costs associated with the designated international dragon boat race.
- 4. Responsible for related transportation and accommodation arrangements.
- 5. Must comply with all the rules and regulations of international races.
- 6. Three weeks upon the completion of the race, the Affiliated Club Representative Team must submit the expense report with all supporting receipts and a copy of the certificate of participation to HKCDBA.
- 7. Ensure the discipline and behavior of all team members overseas comply with the "Code of Conduct for Hong Kong Team".


2015-16 Program Details

- The select criteria are based on the Hong Kong Cup Race held at the 17th Hong Kong Dragon Boat Championships.
- 2. Whenever there is related race, the winner of the Hong Kong Cup Standard Boat 500-meter Race will be recommended to participate in designated international dragon boat race abroad as Hong Kong Affiliated Clubs otherwise 1st runner up and so on.
- 3. Arrange Affiliated Club Representative Club to participate in designated overseas international races recommended by HKCDBA (will consider races in China, Taiwan and Malaysia etc.).
- 4. The sponsorship varies based on the cost of the trip (i.e. accommodation and transportation); however, the tentative sponsorship from HKCDBA is currently capped at HK\$60,000. Affiliated Club Representative Team is responsible to pay the difference if any if the actual expense is more than HK\$60,000. Three weeks upon the completion of the race, the Affiliated Club Representative Team must submit the expense report with all supporting receipts and a copy of the certificate of participation to HKCDBA.
- 5. HKCDBA reserves the right to edit and modify every detail of the Affiliated Club Representative Team Program without prior notice.

Summary

As a long-term plan for the Association, HKCDBA plans to keep two representative teams:

- 1. The "Hong Kong Team" or "National Team" Operating cost is partially funding by the Leisure and Cultural Services Department. Training of this team is arranged directly by HKCDBA and they will represent Hong Kong to participate in races mainly arranged by SF&OC, International Dragon Boat Federation and Asian Dragon Boat Federation, such as: the Asian Games, East Asian Games, Beach Games, World Dragon Boat Championships, Dragon World Cup, Asian Dragon Boat Championships and other races.
- 2. Affiliated Club Representative Team Operation cost is partially funded by HKCDBA. Must be winner(s) of the Hong Kong Cup 500-meter Race held at the annual "Hong Kong Dragon




