INFORMATION BULLETIN No. 2

The information of Bulletin No 2 is complementary to Bulletin No 1. The two Bulletins together serve as complete guidance.

The United States Dragon Boat Federation (USDBF) in conjunction with the International Dragon Boat Federation (IDBF), cordially invite Club Crews from around the world to participate in the 13th IDBF Club Crew World Dragon Boat Championships, which will be held at Nathan Benderson Park (NBP) located in Sarasota, Florida. Team arrival and training will be held Friday, July 15th to Monday, July 18th. Competition will be held from Tuesday, July 19 to Sunday, July 24, 2022.

REGISTRATION

Please note that **May 22, 2022** is the deadline for confirmed entry to be made on the IDBF online registration interface <https://idbfchamps.org/idbf>. Instructions for using the online registration are contained in Bulletin 1. In addition, we ask you to upload the details of the participants/athletes to the IDBF system as soon as possible, with a final deadline of **June 19, 2022**.

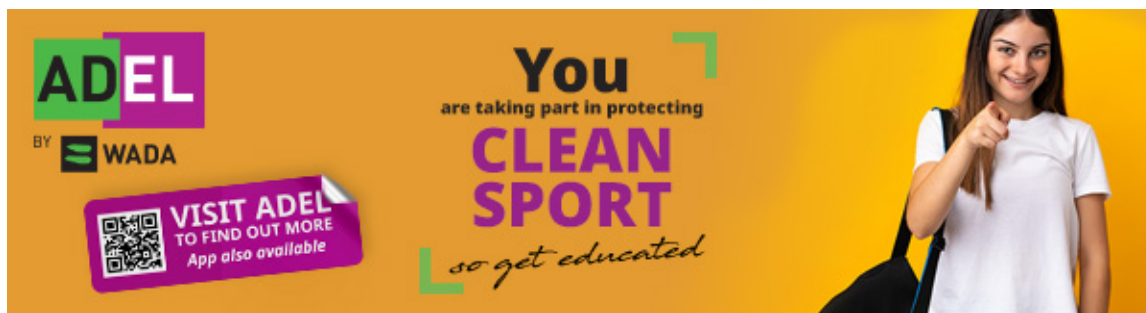
REMINDER - Anti-Doping Requirements

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CHAMPIONSHIPS EXEMPTION REQUEST

IDBF appreciates the challenges clubs have endured over the last 2 years. Should a club find themselves struggling to meet competition class requirements to be able to compete at CCWC, please contact chair-ctc@dragonboat.sport to request an exemption request.

TEAM DASHBOARD

The local organizing committee requests that all participating clubs register for a Team Dashboard utilizing the EventConnect system. Team Managers will utilize this system to make payments, upload information and purchase items such as transportation passes, lunch tickets and closing party tickets. Clubs who have paid the Administration Fee via credit card, or who have blocked accommodations through EventConnect, have already created a Dashboard.

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE TRANSFER

Sarasota-Bradenton International (SRQ) Airport

Shuttle transportation will be available between Sarasota-Bradenton International Airport and CCWC Partner Hotels. Arrival shuttles will run Thursday, July 14th through Sunday, July 17th and departure shuttles will run Monday July 25th. Price: **USD \$30** per person, round-trip

Other Regional Airports

Discounted service can be arranged through the organizing committee's transportation partner, Dolphin Transportation. Service is available from Tampa International Airport, Southwest Florida International Airport and Orlando International Airport.

LOCAL TRANSPORTATION

Training Day Shuttle

On official training days, a shuttle will run on a schedule between CCWC Partner Hotels and the venue. Price: **USD \$40** per person, valid for unlimited rides during official training days.

Race Day Shuttle

On official race days, a shuttle will run on a schedule between CCWC Partner Hotels and the venue. Price: **USD \$150** per person, valid for unlimited rides during official racing days.

****Clubs who have booked accommodations through the EventConnect system will receive a 50% discount on Race Day Shuttle passes****

Club-Dedicated Transportation

Discounted club-dedicated transportation can be arranged through transportation partner, Dolphin Transportation. This service is available to all clubs residing in any accommodation within the Sarasota-Bradenton area.

Parking

Parking will be available onsite for clubs who wish to drive. Rates listed below are discounted for participating clubs. Each pass is valid for one vehicle.

- USD \$75 – Package Pass for all race days
- USD \$25 – Package Pass for all training days
- USD \$10 – One-day Parking Pass for training or race days





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BOOKING TRANSPORTATION

When possible, Team Managers should book transportation for the entire club. Individuals may book SRQ Airport transfers if preferred.

The deadline to purchase Shuttle Passes or book dedicated transportation is June 19, 2022.

CLUB TENTS

Clubs will be provided dedicated space within a shared, unfurnished tent area. Club locations within the shared tent will be assigned once the race schedule and entries have been finalized.

In addition, private tents may be reserved by Clubs through the organizing committee. The organizing committee is offering a package of a 20' x 20' tent, twenty (20) chairs and two (2) 8' tables for USD \$450.00 + tax, which can be purchased through the [EventConnect Team Dashboard](#). You will need to login to access the Team Dashboard.

LUNCH ON THE RACING DAYS

The Athlete Village at Nathan Benderson Park will include an air-conditioned dining hall with ability to monitor the racing, available throughout the day to those who chose the daily lunch plan. Each day of competition, pre-ordered lunches will be available from 11am – 1:30pm in the dining hall. Information on lunch ticket pricing and menus will be posted at www.2022CCWC.com by May 1, 2022.

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INSURANCE

The organizer of the CCWC will have liability insurance for the event. However, we raise your attention to make sure that everyone has his/her own personal insurance with sport activity supplement!

USE OF THE LOGO OF CCWC2022

The official logo of the 13th IDBF Dragon Boat Club Crew World Championships (Sarasota 2022) is protected. Use of the logo is only possible with the written consent of the 13th CCWC Organizing Committee. Copy and use of the logo without permission will result in legal consequences.

USE OF THE IDBF EMBLEM OR LOGO

Clubs must first seek permission from the IDBF before any IDBF emblem or logo can be used on race clothing or equipment. Use of the IDBF emblem and logo is restricted and cannot be used without express written consent from the IDBF. Please email CCWC2022@dragonboat.sport your request for use and include any mock up designs.

TRAININGS / PRACTICE

Training opportunity will be provided at Nathan Benderson Park from July 15th through the morning of July 18th. Because of the large number of participants, training times are limited. Each team can reserve up to 2 training sessions (60 minutes per occasion) per entry class. The two training sessions cannot be on the same day! The registration for trainings (only online is possible) will **open on June 25, 2022**. The technical details of the training sessions will be published later.

CREW / CLUB HISTORY

Clubs are asked to provide photos and information that can be used for Championship publications, announcing and event promotion. Information may be submitted through the [EventConnect Team Dashboard](#), by logging in and following the link in the "Registration Requirements" box.

REGATTA FEES

An IDBF Registration fee (payable to the IDBF) and a Championships Administration Fee (payable to the 13th CCWC Organizing Committee) is to be paid by every athlete, coach and team official attending the Sarasota 2022 CCWC. See the section below on "**PAYMENTS**" for information on how to pay these fees.

IDBF Registration Fee – All competitors including all team officials and coaches of age 19 and over are required to pay an IDBF registration fee of **USD \$50**. Those of age 18 or under are required to pay a registration fee of **USD \$25**.

Administration Fee – All competitors including all team officials and coaches of age 19 and over are required to pay an administration fee of **USD \$80**, payable to the Organizing Committee. Those of age 18 or under are required to pay an administration fee of **USD \$40**.

Supporters Fee – A fee of **USD \$25** per person is payable to the Organizing Committee for all official supporters who require access to the competitor's area. Children of supporters under the age of 16 are free.

Administration Fees paid after June 19, 2022 may be subject to a surcharge of USD \$285 per Club.

Accommodating the clubs with late submission of Final Named Entries into the race program cannot be guaranteed. In case it is still possible to solve, Late Named Entries will require a late entry fee of USD \$55 per club, payable to IDBF to cover the admin costs of making late changes to the racing program.

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ANNEX A

COVID-19 Protocols and Policies

The IDBF and the USDBF consider the health and safety of all participants, coaches, staff and volunteers a top priority. In partnership with the Local Organizing Committee, we have prepared the following protocols and policies aimed at preventing and reducing the spread of Covid-19. As is the case with all events, there is an implied risk when gathering in large groups, and we encourage participants to make personal choices that prioritize their health and wellbeing.

Attendees (Participants, Spectators, Volunteers & Vendors):

1. In order to mitigate risk, we encourage attendees to monitor themselves for any symptoms and complete a screening checklist at home before attending the event, using their local public officials' list of Covid-19 symptoms. Any attendee who is experiencing any Covid-19 symptoms is encouraged to err on the side of caution when deciding to attend the event.
2. In the event a team member or attendee experiences Covid-19 symptoms or tests positive for Covid-19 during the event, individuals are expected to notify their team manager. Team managers are required to report individuals who test positive to the Event Medical Director. Individuals who test positive, and any others who have been in close proximity to the infected individual, are expected to isolate in their hotel rooms until they produce a negative Covid-19 test. A list of testing locations is reproduced in the table below.
3. Attendees are encouraged to follow basic hygiene procedures.
4. Face masks are not mandatory on-site, but attendees and volunteers are strongly encouraged to wear them, particularly when in areas where there may be increased contact with others.
5. Attendees are encouraged to maintain social distancing while in their respective team sites and while walking around the event site.

General Event Site:

1. Hand sanitation stations will be placed in various locations throughout the event site.
2. Teams will receive dedicated space, free of charge, in the Team Village area. This space may be located within one large tent. Teams who wish to have their own tent may reserve one for an additional fee. Additional information is provided in Bulletin 2.
3. The venue is a very expansive, 600-acre outdoor park with ample space for social distancing. The Team Village will be accessible to credentialed Team Members and Team Supporters only. The general public will not have access to this area.

Racing:

1. The IDBF strongly encourages participants to bring their own paddles and PFDs. However, paddles and PFDs will be available on-site for participants to use. Disinfectant wipes and hand sanitizer will be available within the marshalling area for use by participants. If teams want their boat to be wiped down before embarking, they can use the disinfectant wipes available in Marshalling to do so. This will not be done by volunteers.
2. Marshalling lanes will be widened to provide additional distance between individual teams and paddlers.



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3. Masks are strongly encouraged in the marshalling area and may be removed when the boat has pushed away from the dock.
4. There will be a boat loading and unloading sequence to maintain separation between teams.
5. Volunteers in marshaling are expected to have minimal contact with participants. It will be the responsibility of teams to assist their own team members in loading and unloading boats.
